The Neighbourhood Plan draft report has now been available for comment since the Street Fayre on 11th June. During that time, every household, business, land owner and many clubs/societies within the Parish should have received a leaflet explaining what the Neighbourhood Plan is setting out to achieve, along with guidance on how to access the report and to leave any comments. If you have not received this leaflet then there is still time to go to our website at www.w-w-w.org.uk where you will find links to all relevant information. The deadline for making comments is Saturday 6th August!

Someone will get back to you as soon as possible to assist. Copies of the draft report are also available to read in the Library and the Parish Council offices.

A series of "drop-in" sessions have been held throughout the consultation period, along with an Open Forum event that took place on 23rd July. The last of the "drop-in" sessions will take place on Thursday 4th August between 10am and 11.30am in the Precinct Coffee Stop Café so come along and meet us if you have any points you wish to discuss. Don't miss the chance to have your say as this is Your Neighbourhood Plan!

After the 6th August, all feedback will be reviewed and amendments made to the report where these are supported by the Parish Council. More details on the subsequent steps towards getting the Neighbourhood Plan fully accepted as part of the local planning process will be covered in next month's article.
