In June we will be launching the draft version of the Neighbourhood Plan report. This will include a wide range of policies that are expected to have an impact on the future of our Parish over the next 15 years. Once the report is finalised, which should be by early next year, this will become an integral part of the District Local Plan (Core Strategy) and, as such, will be in a position to influence planning developments that affect our community.

Please come along and meet us at the Wellesbourne Street Fayre on 11th June where members of the team will be happy to discuss the Plan. In addition, during June every household, business, club and society within the Parish will receive a leaflet explaining where you can access the draft report on-line and how to provide any comments you may wish to make.

We will also be organising a series of drop-in sessions within Wellesbourne where you can come along and discuss the draft report. Look out for posters around the villages, which will let you know where and when these sessions will take place.

Finally on Saturday 23rd July, between 11am and 3pm, we will be hosting an open forum session in St Peter's Church Hall where you can come along and see a wide variety of posters and maps that provide details on the policies that are being proposed. More on this in next month's news article but please do make a note in your diary to come along!

The draft report will remain open for your comments until Saturday 6th August, after which all feedback will be reviewed and changes made where this is supported by the Parish Council. Don't miss the chance to have your say as this is Your Neighbourhood Plan!
