



Neighbourhood Plan advances!

The Neighbourhood Plan report is now on the agenda for the next Stratford District Cabinet Meeting, which is scheduled to take place on 30th July. By the time you read this article it is likely that this meeting will have already taken place and hopefully we will have secured the support of District Councillors to progress our Neighbourhood Plan towards a referendum where all residents within the Parish will have the chance to vote on whether the Plan should be accepted. If we receive a vote in support of the Plan, this will then become linked to the District Local Plan (Core Strategy) where it must then be taken into account in any land use related planning applications that arise within our Parish.

We will share more information with you about when the referendum will be taking place and how you will be able to vote over the coming months. In the meantime, the Neighbourhood Plan team is busy preparing publicity material which will include leaflets for delivery to all homes plus posters and banners for display around the Parish, along with press articles in the run-up to the referendum.

Furthermore, in order to keep residents up to date with developments, a Neighbourhood Plan e-mail network has now been created which already has over 250 members.
