



Feedback received on Neighbourhood Plan!

We are pleased to say that feedback has now been received from the Independent Examiner who has been able to provide a review of the policies that have been included as part of our Neighbourhood Plan. The Independent Examiner is a qualified professional whose primary task is to ensure that all of our policies are compliant with UK and EU planning regulations and meet specific conditions in regard to environmental and sustainability standards.

The recommendations for changes that have been made will now be checked by the Neighbourhood Plan team and any misconceptions notified back to the Independent Examiner. Once the final report is released, which is likely to be sometime in May, this will be made available on the Parish Council and Neighbourhood Plan websites for general viewing.

The Neighbourhood Plan team will also now begin the task of going through the recommendations from the Independent Examiner and consider where updates to our main Submission Report might be needed. Any changes will be reviewed with both the Parish and District Council in order to reach agreement on a revised version of the Submission Report. This will then form the basis for seeking community-wide approval of the Neighbourhood Plan through a referendum later in the year. We will keep you updated on progress through monthly articles in this Newsletter.
