


## Input to Wellesbourne & Walton News – October Edition



### Phase 1 of Neighbourhood Plan now complete!

The Neighbourhood Plan team has accomplished its first target of completing a series of engagements with local residents, organisations and businesses in order to establish your opinions on the main likes, dislikes and wishes for the future of our villages!

Building upon the success of the earlier events at the Wellesbourne Street Fayre and both the School and the Walton Fetes, the team held an “Open Forum” session in Chedham’s Yard on 1<sup>st</sup> September where visitors were able to see what feedback has been received so far and to add their own views to the wealth of comments already given. The preliminary analysis of results shows some interesting trends, with a fairly balanced mix between likes, dislikes and wishes along with a strong emphasis on the key issues of community wellbeing, housing, traffic and green/open space, as depicted in the diagram.



The team will now start the task of preparing a questionnaire, based on all the feedback that has been received. This will take the form of predominantly an on-line survey directed to all residents, organisations and businesses so that we can get a comprehensive view from as many of you as possible on the future of our villages. A paper version of the questionnaire will also be made available for those of you that don’t wish to use the on-line option. “Drop in” sessions will also be organised where anyone can come along and seek clarification on the questions being posed and to get help as necessary in filling in the form.

The launch date for the questionnaire is expected to be in early November. Watch out for the posters, leaflets and press releases that will advertise the launch and tell you how to access the form ahead of this date!
