



## **Neighbourhood Plan Referendum: make your vote count!**

The Neighbourhood Plan Referendum takes place at the Village Hall on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> October between 7am and 10pm.

The question on the voting paper is whether you would like to accept the Neighbourhood Plan, or not. It's your chance to decide whether local residents, through the Neighbourhood Plan, should have a greater say about any land-use related developments that might affect our Parish through to 2031.

The policies in the Neighbourhood Plan cover important local issues including:

- Influence over the location of any new housing
- Support for sustainable, affordable housing
- Support for Wellesbourne Airfield and local businesses
- Protection for local green spaces and allotments
- Protection of heritage landscape, buildings, woodlands and views

All residents over 18 in Wellesbourne & Walton who are registered to vote can take part in the Referendum on Thursday 11th October. By now, you should have received your voting card or made arrangements to vote by post or proxy. If you haven't received a voting card, call Stratford District Council on 01789 260208.

On the day of the Referendum, if you would like to vote but find it difficult to get to the Village Hall, please call 07967 057448 and we will try to get a member of the Neighbourhood Plan team to give you a lift.

The Referendum is the last step in a process that has taken four years. Please help to ensure a good turn-out by voting, and encouraging family and friends to vote as well. It's our plan, our say, our future!
